Our Year 4 and 5 students began their ScopelT computer coding course on Monday. The first of 10 lessons provided an introduction to basic coding principals that will be built upon throughout the term. It was great to see our classes so engaged in these initial activities – I'm confident that they will learn some valuable skills and knowledge as the course progresses.

Last week's Cross Country Carnival was a terrific event, with excellent participation and organisation. Concerns about the weather were not realised, and a good crowd saw some excellent runners show off their speed and stamina. Thanks to Mr Weiley for his organisation, and to the School Canteen for their wonderful catering.

Next Tuesday to Thursday our Year 3 and 5 students will participate in their NAPLAN tests in literacy and numeracy. These tests provide a snapshot of how each student is performing, and also give a comparison to their peers in the school and across Australia. No particular additional preparation is required, other than the usual good night's sleep and a healthy breakfast. When results become available, parents are encouraged to discuss them with teachers.

School funding continues to be in the news, particularly with regard to Gonski funding. I encourage you to follow this issue, as it directly impacts upon the level of support we can offer to develop each of our students.
